

Clubhouse Restaurant Dress Code

Attire for the family friendly Clubhouse is country club casual. It is expected that Members and visitors will choose to dress in a fashion befitting the surroundings and atmosphere provided in the setting of the Country Club. We ask that Members also inform their guests of dress requirements as to not put the staff or fellow Members into a difficult situation.

<u>Gentlemen</u>

- Collared shirts; not required to be tucked in.
- Dress sweaters are permitted without a collared shirt.
- T-shirts of any kind are not permitted.

Ladies

- Exposed midriffs and short shorts are not permitted.
- Hats, caps, and visors are permitted on the verandas before 5p.
- Dress hats are allowed at all times inside and outside.

All Patrons

- Dress denim is permitted; no cutoffs, holes, or frays.
- Dress or Bermuda Shorts are permitted.
- Sweatshirts hooded or non are not permitted.
- Clothing with graphics are not allowed and logos must be smaller than 4 inches.
- Swimwear and cover-ups are not permitted.
- Gym clothes are not permitted.
- Baseball style caps and visors must be removed while inside the Clubhouse Restaurant.
- "Athleisure" is allowed only before 3pm.
- Proper footwear required athletic cleats or spikes are not permitted.
- Jackets are not required, except for certain functions.
- Knit hats are allowed while dining on the verandas in cooler weather.
- Parents with children under the age of 6 should use appropriate discretion when dressing their children-collars preferred.
